The Watermark Credit Union was in the process of moving its corporate headquarters to the newly renovated Roffe Building in downtown Seattle. The open office concept was designed to match the company's culture of collaboration and teamwork on all four floors. The big problem was that the concrete ceiling created so much reverberation, worker efficiency was definitely going to be compromised.
