White River Amphitheater hosts many musical events. With the majestic Mt. Ranier in the background White River Amphitheater provides a breathtaking venue for today's most popular entertainers.

During the initial design stages of the amphitheater a metal roof deck was added to shelter concert-goers

from any rain showers and to provide shade from the sun in the hot summer months.

The large spanning roof deck created a reverberant surface for sound to bounce from. Additionally, during rain storms, the sound of rain on the metal deck would be deafening.

K-13 was an effective solution to both problems. At a thickness of 1 1/2", K-13 provides an unequalled NRC rating of 1.05 on a ribbed metal deck. Superior acoustic control, ability to conform to any substrate configuration and an attractive uniform texture made K-13 the best choice for the White River Amphitheater.
